A. Knowledge of the Scout Program

1. Know the Mafeking history and the milestone of Scouting.
2. Know the story of the left handshake.
3. Know the meaning of the scout sign, fleur de lies & the World badge.
4. Know the Scout Law and Promise, Motto and the badge system.
5. Have a copy of the scheduled Scout Program for the year.
6. Have a copy of the member's list and telephone numbers.

B. Skills Development

1. Be able to conduct the Opening ceremony.
2. Be able to lead a minimum of 4 games as a Game Leader.
3. Be able to conduct a minimum of 2 training sessions with topics assigned by the Section Leader. The training sessions will include proper research and preparation of training materials and handouts for the Scouts.
4. Knowledge and ability to lead 5 campfire songs.
5. Knowledge of a minimum of 10 knots plus 2 lashings.

C. Resource Development

1. Have a copy (soft or hard copy) of Scout Games book or similar books or materials.
2. Have a copy (soft or hard copy) of Campfire song book or similar books or materials.
3. Have a copy (soft or hard copy) of knotting book or similar books or materials.
4. Maintain a personal library or log book of resource materials.

D. Personal Development

1. Smart and proper uniform according to 33rd Group standard.
2. Always salute to other leaders and return salute to Scouts.
3. Always aim for and working on achieving a higher standard in Duke of Edinburgh's Award, Queen's Venturer or Chief Scout Award.

E. Administration

1. Know the members personally.
2. Perform uniform check, including personal log and Scout book.
3. Check member's attendance and follow up reasons for absence from meetings.
4. Collect return slips from own patrol being mentored.
5. Update progress chart after badge testing.
6. Maintain good order within the Patrols during meeting and discipline members when necessary.
7. Set an example for the members to follow.
8. Inform Section Leader when not being able to make it to the meeting.
