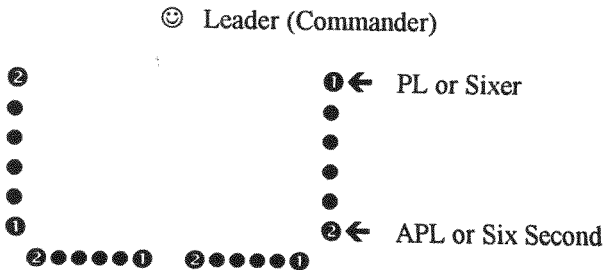


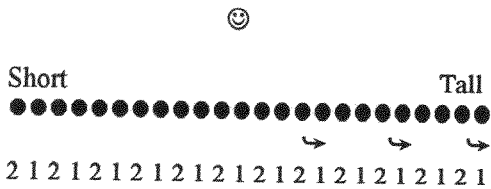

Open Square

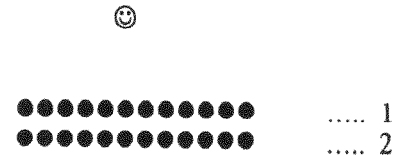


2 Lines Formation



Steps

1. Fall in from one single line from tall to short
2. Have scouts numbered off
3. Forming 2 lines
4. Tidy up the lines



Command

GROUP (Troop/Pack), FALL IN

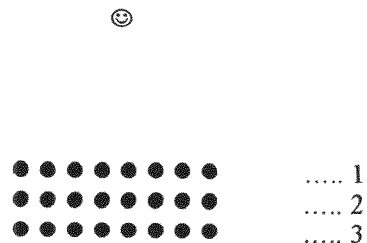
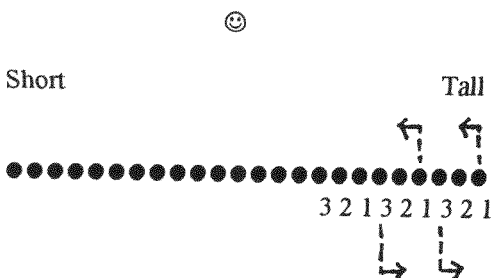
GROUP, FROM THE RIGHT:
BY 2, BY 2, NUMBER

EVEN NUMBERS:
FORM 2, FORM 2, DEEP

DRESSING, DRESSING TO THE
RIGHT: RIGHT DRESS

EYES: EYES FRONT

3 Lines Formation



Same as above *EXCEPT:*

Substitute BY 2 as BY 3
EVEN NUMBERS as ODD NUMBERS
FORM 2 as FORM 3

Basic Commands

| <u>Action</u> | <u>Command</u> |
|--|---|
| Falling In | Group/Troop/Pack: Fall-IN |
| Falling Out | Group/Troop/Pack: Turn to the right - Fall-OUT |
| Bring the group to the alert position | Group/Troop/Pack, Group/Troop/Pack : ALERT |
| Bring the group to the at ease position | Group/Troop/Pack: STAND AT EASE |
| Allow the boys to stand easy | STANDING EASY |
| Resume previous position | AS-YOU-WERE |
| To turn right | Group/T/P Turning, Turning to the right, RIGHT TURN |
| To turn left | Group/T/P Turning, Turning to the left, LEFT TURN |
| To make a 180 degree turn | Group/T/P Turning, ABOUT, ABOUT: TURN |
| To sound off (and find out the number of boys) | Group Fall-In (fall in in a straight line) Group, Group: ALERT From the Right, By NUMBER |
| To group the boys in twos | Group Fall-In (fall-in in a straight line) Group, Group: ALERT From the Right, By TWO, BY TWO: NUMBER |



HAND SIGNALS

SIXER/PL 2-SECOND X-SCOUTS CUB LEADERS DIRECTION



Freeze

Scouts acknowledge with same signal and wait further orders.



Come In

This signal is most used in field games to bring Scouts in to Leader.



Hurry Up

Clenched fist pumped up and down vigorously.



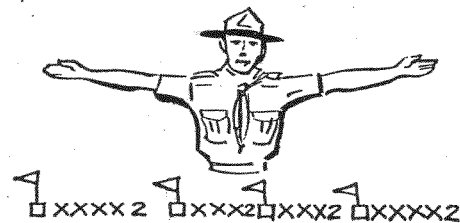
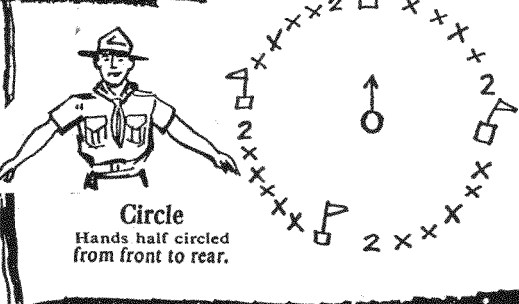
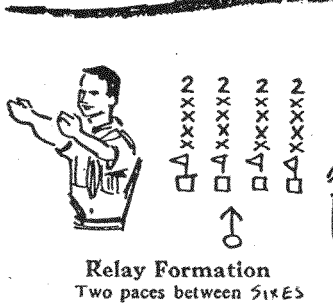
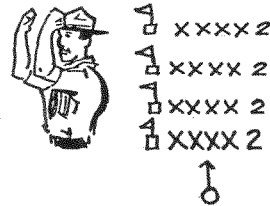
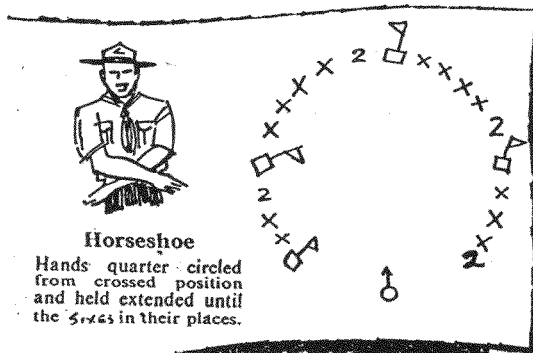
Squat

Open palm facing down, arm moved down.

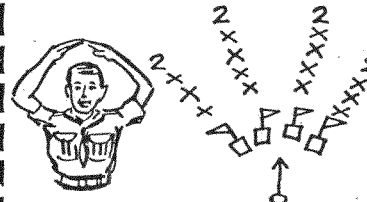


Stand Up

Open palm facing up, arm moved upward.



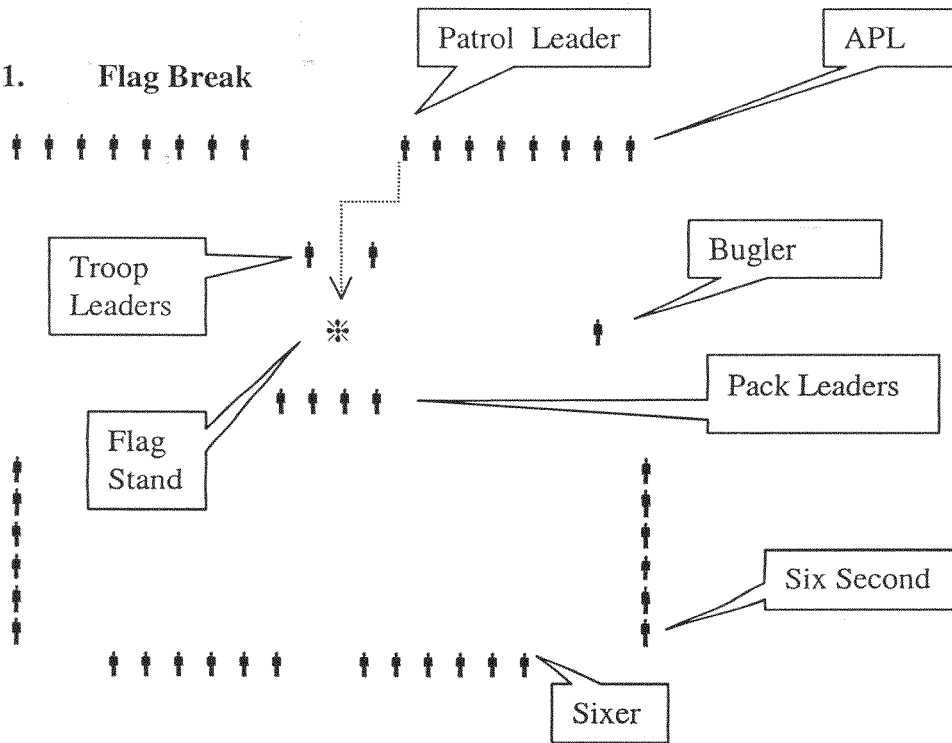
Troop in one rank facing to or from the Scouter according to position of his palms.
