Re: Department Standards

In a recent leaders meeting, we agreed on the importance of maintaining a basic dress standard for the troop. This standard is in place because we want the scouts to demonstrate pride in the organization, and to help with the development of team spirit. Although the dress standard has been provided to all new scouts, a reminder will hopefully help improve the overall deportment of the group. Please note the following requirements:

- Hair: Must be clean and presentable. Scouts with long hair must tie it back
- Shirts: All badges and crests are to be applied according to Scouts Canada guidelines. Refer to your Scouting manual for details
- Neckerchief: Required for each meeting
- Beret: Required for each meeting
- Sweater: Blue or black are acceptable. No logos are to be visible
- Jacket: Scout uniform jacket is preferred. Other jackets must be approved by the group commissioner
- Pants: Blue cargo pants are required. Pants must be proper length (socks should not be visible)
- Belt: Scouts issue only
- Socks: Black or dark blue only
- Shoes: Black polishable shoes are mandatory
- Jewelry: Not permitted, unless approved by the troop commissioner

In addition to this standard, each scout should have a 33rd Troop activity shirt. These have recently come available, and each scout will need to bring \$10 to the next meeting in order to obtain their shirt.
